#### Changes of Note from the 2022 AMFA AGM affecting our local Festival:

- 16 & Under Provincial Classes have been changed to 17 & under.
- 14 & Under Provincial Classes have been added for Musical Theatre, Strings, Piano, and Speech.
- 9 & Under Provincial Class has been added for Piano Plan I (minimum grade 3).
- Piano Duets have been removed from Plan I & II and are their own class now. Two new Provincial duet classes
- have been added, one for 12 & under, one for 13 & over.
- All Choral Classes at Provincials will be in Audio Recorded format as opposed to in person.

We will be aligning our classes locally with the Provincial classes. As such, we will be using a modified Syllabus which has the age categories as well as includes our own local addenda classes.
